Market on Main

Colorado Mesa University will be attending the market tonight to celebrate its new storefront opening this fall at the former Candytime Shoppe on the corner of 5th & Main Street.

Dave stated that Taylor from Rooted Valley Hair Salon organized a 7th Street block party during the market. Most of the businesses on the 600 block are women-owned businesses. Businesses donated items to contribute to a gift basket that will be raffled off during market.

4th of July Parade

The 4th of July parade went well. There were approximately 40 entries with a great number of classic cars that participated as well as a Grand Marshall who was a World War II Veteran. Scott Iles assists with coordinating the 4th of July parade and Parade of Lights. Kyra stated that Scott does a great job.

Abe stated that he was very appreciative of the parade postcard notifications that were sent out to those who live in the staging area.

Cinco de Mayo

A meeting was held with the Latin Anglo Alliance Foundation, Greater Grand Junction Sports Commission staff, and Downtown Grand Junction staff to discuss Cinco de Mayo. This year the event was held at Las Colonias Park instead of Downtown; however, due to inherent costs the Latin Anglo Alliance Foundation requested the event be held on Main Street in Downtown on the first Saturday in May. The Latin Anglo Alliance Foundation is a nonprofit organization that promotes Latino culture and is volunteer based. The alcohol sales from the event provides youth scholarships.

Kyra will help with the organization of the event next year to ensure road closures are done accurately and liquor boundaries are enforced. In addition, Downtown Grand Junction will help promote the event.

Rides and Vibes

In 2024 Rides & Vibes Mountain Bike Race and Downtown Music Festival will be moved to the 2nd weekend in May. We are anticipating that rider registration will increase with this change since there are other bike events scheduled the 1st weekend in May. In addition, this will allow Cinco de Mayo to schedule their event the 1st weekend in May.
